Notes regarding the "3 Day Camp + Dress Rehearsal" Schedule

Youth Worship Camp is designed for children and students ages 7-17 years. Children who are younger than seven and haven't completed the first grade generally do not have the attention span and self control to stay focused and on task for long periods of time. Students who are 18 years old and graduated from high school are in a different life season. We suggest 18 year olds who desire to participate be given helper / assistant roles. Children younger than seven must have a parent accompany them individually at all times. A parent serving as a "buddy" to their child may not be on the "Serve Team". All questions about exceptions will be considered on an individual basis with Dr. Greg to make the final decision. Nursery will be provided for young children of SERVE TEAM only.

Dr. Greg prefers 45 minute music rotations. When groups are not in Worship Music Coaching they will be in Bible Study or Messianic Dance. Each group will experience all three breakout sessions each day of camp. For Dress Rehearsal day, the groups will be divided for Bible study / Gospel Presentation and snack time but then practice the dance and rehearse for the service at the same time.

This schedule is based on 2 different music groups (Children's Choir & Youth Band), 3 different Bible study groups (6/7 -9 years, 10-12 years, 13 & up) and 2 different dance circles (beginning and intermediate). The three groups can be referred to by colored teams (Red Team, Blue Team, Green Team etc.)

We will provide video and instruction for a Messianic Dance Camp International Dance to a theme song for camp. The teenagers would learn this version. We suggest having a modified, more simple version for children and those not familiar with Messianic Dance. It is helpful to have adults or helpers planted between the dancers to help with proximity / crowd control and to keep the circle moving.

Parents are asked to sign their camper in and out each day of camp and for dress rehearsal. We recommend parents drop off and pick up from the same location - preferably where the opening and closing rallies are held. For security reasons, teenagers who drive themselves will be dismissed first and then children will be released as their parents sign them out. On Saturday a parent / guardian will need to stay on campus for their student(s) during sound check and Shabbat activities.

Volunteers are encouraged to come <u>Monday</u> during camp week for <u>Serve Team training</u>. This preparation day will include a time of worship, encouragement from Scripture (from Rabbi), prayer for the week and then camp set up, decorating etc.
